Every morning, the dog and Mr. Uyeno walked together to the Shibuya Train Station in Tokyo. The professor said "goodbye" to Hachi and took the train to work. Hachi waited for the professor at the train station. Every evening the professor *returned from the university on the train. [2]

One morning the professor and Hachi walked to the train station as usual. The professor said "goodbye" to Hachi and got on the train. That day, the professor got very sick at work, and he died. In the evening, Hachi was waiting for the professor at the train station. [3]

Every day Hachi *continued to wait at Shibuya Train Station for the professor. People at the train station saw Hachi every day. They saw him every day for ten years! Sometimes they talked to Hachi or gave him food. Finally, on March 8, 1935, Hachi died. Where did he die? [4]

People thought Hachi was a very good friend to the professor. [5] They put a *statue of Hachi at Shibuya Train Station.

Today, people still remember Hachi. The statue of Hachi is a popular meeting place. Shibuya Train Station is very busy. If you want to meet a friend near Shibuya Train Station, you can say, "Meet me at the Hachi."

【8】 次の英文を読み、あとの問いに答えなさい。

“They swam like fish, and made a noise like a wild horse. ①They were birds that could not fly – but they jumped out of the water.” (A) In 1498, the *Portuguese traveler *Vasco da Gama was surprised to see ②these animals in *the Atlantic Ocean, far from land. They were penguins, and they are still some of the most interesting and popular animals of the ocean. (B)

There are eighteen *species of penguin in the world today. Two species – the *Adelie and the *Emperor penguins – live in *Antarctica, but the others live in the southern oceans, and they spend most of their time (sometimes as much as 80% of it) in the sea. All penguins have black backs and white fronts; ③this helps to protect them when they are in the water, because it is difficult to see them from above or from below. They do not have the same *wings and *tails as birds that fly in the air; they have little short wings and tails, and big feet which help them to ‘fly’ in the water. But different species have different *colours on their heads, and penguins can be as small as a chicken or as big as a small child.

It is often funny to watch penguins on land because their bodies look fat and *uncomfortable. (C) ④Penguins stopped flying and began to live in the water about fifty million years ago, and their bodies have slowly changed. Now the water moves easily over their bodies, and this means they can travel fast; as much as twenty-four *kilometres *per hour. (D) They can also travel a long way. Emperor penguins, for example, can stay at sea for a month and travel almost 1,600 kilometres.
