



Do you know the song "Happy Birthday to You"? It is a very popular song in English-speaking countries. Also, people sing it in more than 150 different languages. The history of "Happy Birthday to You" is very interesting A it started with a different name and was not \*originally made for celebrating birthdays.

In 1893, an American school teacher named Mildred Hill wanted a song that teachers could sing to their students at the beginning of the day. She wrote the music, and her sister, Patty Hill, wrote the words. The song's name was "Good Morning to All." It was a very simple song, and went like this: "Good morning to you / Good morning to you / Good morning dear children / Good morning to all." The Hill sisters shared their song in a printed songbook. Many teachers used it to begin their classes each day.

In 1924, the song "Good Morning to All" was printed again in another song book. B, this time it was a little different. There was a second part that had "Happy Birthday to You." Who wrote these words? No one knows. Today it is still a mystery.

The new words "Happy Birthday to you" were more popular than the words "Good Morning to All." Soon people started to sing the new song at many birthday parties. C, the song was heard in professional places such as theaters and \*advertising companies.

The \*original song "( ① )" became very popular with the second part and was now making a lot of money. The Hill sisters decided to protect their song. They asked a music company for help, and the company \*made a contract to protect the song. You could sing "Happy Birthday to you" to your family and your friends, but you couldn't sing it in a public place. If you wanted to sing it in a restaurant or use it in something, such as a movie, you had to give money to the music company first. Until 2015, that large music company \*owned the song "( ② )." The company got about \$2 million every year with the song. About half of that money went to the Hill family.

### 【10】東京オリンピックのメダルに関する英文を読み、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Last summer the Tokyo Olympic Games were ( $\mathcal{T}$  hold) in Japan. Japan wanted to make the games special and planned many things. One idea was to make the medals from recycled \*materials.

① The idea came from a group of young Japanese students who wanted to solve environmental problems. Now, there is ②a big problem with garbage from old \*electronic devices. Many people use cell phones and throw them away after only one or two years. 650,000 \*tons of small electronic devices are thrown away every year, but only about 100,000 tons are recycled. In 2016, these students told ③their idea to \*the Tokyo Olympic Committee.

The Olympic Committee liked their idea and started the "Everyone's Medal" program in April 2017. ④[ to / people / their old electronic devices / asked / give / they ] to an NTT Docomo store, or at an environmental center.

Each device has only small pieces of the metals, so the Tokyo Olympic Committee needed millions of devices to make the 5,000 Olympic and \*Paralympic medals. The program ended in March 2019, and by ⑤ then, the Olympic Committee had enough material to make all the medals that were needed. 78,895 tons of devices were collected. They received more than 6 million smartphones. \*In weight, there was 32 kilos of gold, 3,500 kilos of silver, and 2,200 kilos of \*bronze.

6 The medals were shown to the world on July 24, 2019. They were designed by Junichi Kawanishi, an artist in Osaka. On the medals, there are five Olympic rings, the name of the games, and the \*Greek goddess (✓ call) \*Nike.

Japan is the first Olympic \*host country that made all the medals from used electronic devices. The Olympic Committee hopes that people won't buy a new device so quickly after they see the medals.
